



GemCore™ by Reward Cleaning & Maintenance Instructions

1. Immediately after installation, the floor should be dry vacuumed to remove all dust and debris.
2. Then wipe with a vinyl flooring cleaner. Use any brand cleaner specifically made for cleaning vinyl flooring. Use a sponge mop or similar cloth-applicator mops. Be sure to follow the vinyl cleaner manufacturer's instructions.
3. After 5-10 minutes, the floor should be cleaned again with a damp mop to remove all residue of the cleaning agent.
4. Allow the floor to dry for at least 30 minutes before walking on it.

IMPORTANT

- Place walk-off mats at all exterior entrances to catch debris from shoes.
- Always remove excess water as it may cause slip and fall hazards.
- Use soft cleaning towels to spread the cleaner and to clean afterwards. Do not use stiff brushes, scrubbing pads, towels made from stiff natural fibers, or other abrasive materials.
- Do not use soap-based detergents, waxes, caustic cleaners, abrasive cleaners, or any cleaner that leaves a residue that can't easily be removed with water.
- Use non rubber backed floor protectors at entrances.
- Use felt protectors under the legs of furniture to help prevent scratches.
- In locations where people congregate or stand for long periods of time, such as in front of cash registers, sinks, and ovens, use protective mats.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE

Follow the same instructions as under "Initial care after installation".

PERIODIC MAINTENANCE

Depending on the amount of traffic on the floor, periodic maintenance might help to restore the floor's original beauty. Use any regular vinyl floor refresher (such as Bona Hard Floor Refresher) to do the job. Be sure to follow the vinyl floor refresher manufacturer's instructions.
